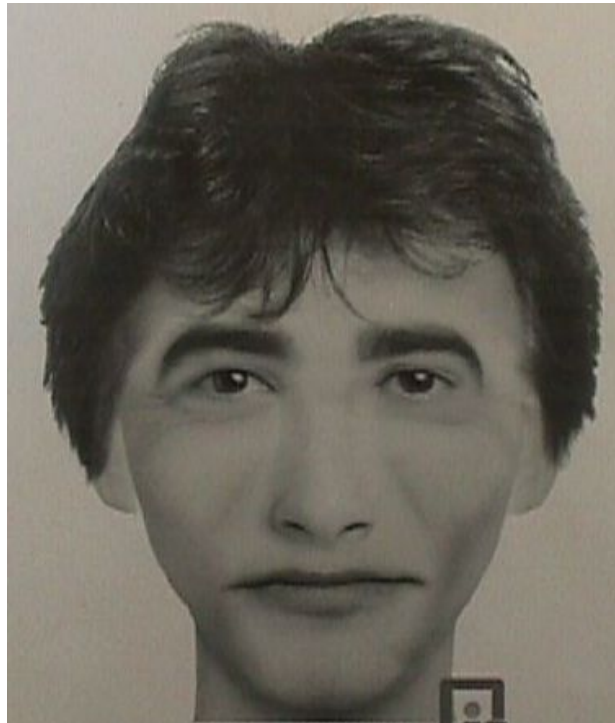

SUSPECT#1



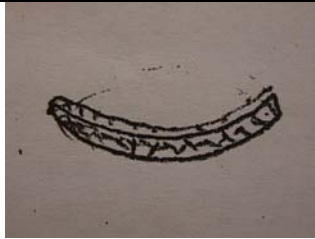


SUSPECT# 2

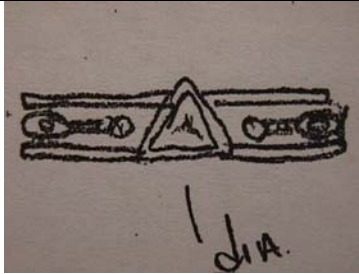
